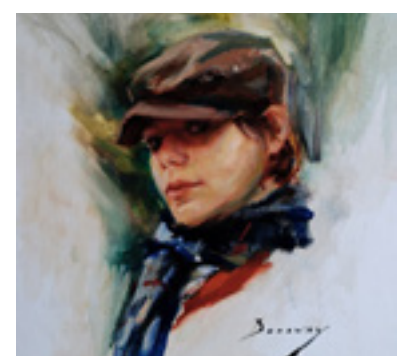
The Photographer's Eye
