- 4 Support rapidly growing *Creating Hand-in-Hand* outreach program; expand bilingual programming to meet needs of Latino community

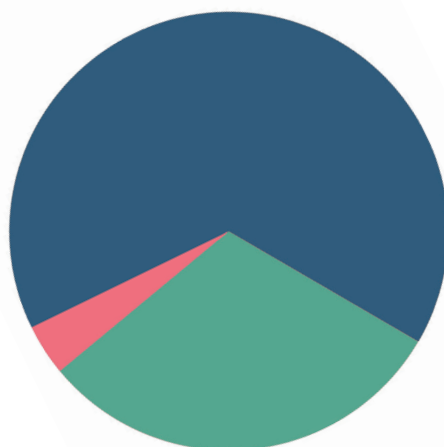
