FAQs

Who can volunteer?

Anyone 18 or older can volunteer for most shifts. For those under 18 can volunteer with a parent or guardian. Beverage and Snack volunteers must be 21 as they will be serving alcoholic beverages.

What volunteer positions do you have?

We need volunteers for laying out the fair, setup, artist registration, entrance cashiers, beverage and snack cashiers, booth sitters, breakfast crew, surveyors, perimeter security, teardown and clean up. Volunteer dates range from the Tuesday prior to the Fair to the Monday following the Fair.

What are the hours of the Fair?

Friday, July 10 and August 7 - 9am - 5pm Saturday, July 11 and August 8 - 9am - 5pm Sunday, July 12 and August 9 - 9am - 3pm

What should I wear?

Volunteers during the event should wear comfortable attire. Please bring sunscreen, a hat and a refillable water bottle. There will be a water station to keep you hydrated! We will provide an Art Association branded apron for you to wear during your shift.

Where do I park?

Parking is limited around Snow King Ball Field and we would like to leave all parking spots within a 3 block radius for shopping patrons. We encourage you to find street parking 3 blocks away or park at the parking garage and walk.

Where do I check-in?

For shifts, Thursday through Sunday, please check-in at the pink Art Association tent in the parking lot of Snow King Ball Field. Let the entrance volunteers you are here to check-in for your volunteer shift. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your shift so you can check-in, receive your Art Association branded apron, understand your role and get to your booth.

For the Tuesday shift, we will be on the Snow King Ball Field.

For the Wednesday shift, we will meet at our storage unit at Old West. Details will be sent in advance.
