Frequently Asked Questions

Welcome to the Art Association of Jackson Hole **Summer Camp!**

Where is drop off and pick up?

Our Summer Camp programming drop off is at 9:00 and pick up is at 3:00 PM. The location for drop off and pick up for both camps is the cement stairs by the big lawn behind the Center. To access, just walk around the Ceramics studio to the right.

What paperwork do I need to turn in and where do I send it?

Our three documents to sign are: A!A Medical Information sheet, Policies and Procedures and Liability Form. We try to be paperless as much as possible, so if you can send it electronically to info@artassociation.org that is great. If not, you can print them or we will have extra copies the first day of camp.

What should my child wear to camp?

We love making messy art projects. With all students we use non-toxic paint and with the little ones we use washable tempera. But, art making can be messy so just have your child wear art-friendly clothing. Also, closed-toed shoes would be preferred.

What if my child is sick or has to miss a day?

If your child is sick or absent for a class during camp please let their instructor know or email info@artassociation.org. If students don't show up for class and we aren't notified ahead of time, we will call parents/guardians to check in on the student. If you are running late, you can also give us a heads up by calling the front desk. If you're student misses a day, we will do our best to catch them up but can't guarantee they will be able to do that day's activities.

What do you do for snacks or lunch?

Please pack both a snack and lunch for your child to have at cmap. Additionally, a water bottle and sunscreen is always a good idea too!

Schedule

Our After School programming starts between 3:00 and 3:45 and ends between 5:00 and 5:15 PM. Our After School programs follow the Teton County School district calendar, so any days that the school systems do not have school, we do not have programming (including inservice days, snow days and breaks)

Drop Off/Pick-Up

We check in students from the Center activity bus stop and escort them to classes. <u>Please emphasize</u> that students must check-in with staff after getting off the bus rather than going to class on their own! Parents can also drop off students if they are coming from around town. After-school programs run in the various A!A studios in the Center for the Arts.

Pick up is between 5:00 and 5:15. Directions to various class locations are included at the end of this document. If a class is in a different location for the day, A!A will notify parents by email.
