***Please read the following information carefully.***

#### **Eligibility**

Any current member of the Art Association may submit artwork for this exhibition.

#### **Commission on Sales**

The Art Association takes a 40% commission on sales, which supports our programs and operations. Credit card fees are split between artist and A!A. Please price your work accordingly.

#### **Requirements**

- Each member may submit 1-2 pieces for this exhibition.
- Maximum width 30.”
- All pieces must have been created within the last year, April 2022 to April 2023.
- Artwork must be for sale.
- Works must be ready to hang (framed and wired, gallery wrapped canvases with wires, or other presentation method).
- 3-D works should be free-standing and able to be shown on a pedestal or floor.
- Any pieces requiring special display, please contact [jenhoffman@artassociation.org](mailto:jenhoffman@artassociation.org) to discuss options.

#### **Labeling**

- Please make sure your work is clearly labeled with the following information
  - Artist Name
  - Title
  - Medium

- Price
- Business card or contact information (email & phone)
- Please include a removable label with your phone number and email address if you do not want that info shared with a buyer.

### **Delivery**

- Artwork may be delivered in person to the Art Association Gallery April 10-12, 2023.
- Gallery hours are 10 AM - 4 PM Monday - Friday.

### **Shipping Artwork**

- Artwork may be shipped to arrive NO LATER THAN APRIL 12 with the following requirements:
  - Artwork must be packed in reusable packing material (NO STYROFOAM PEANUTS).
  - Return shipping must be paid by the shipper (either include a prepaid return shipping label or shipping will be invoiced to the artist).
  - Please take note: there is NO PHYSICAL MAIL DELIVERY IN JACKSON. If you send your work via US Mail, you MUST send it to this address: Art Association Gallery, attn: Jennifer Hoffman, PO Box 1248, Jackson, WY 83001.
  - If shipping via UPS or FedEx, you MUST send it to our physical address: Art Association JH Gallery, attn: Jennifer Hoffman, 240 S Glenwood St, Jackson, WY 83001.
