## Weeks 1 &amp; 2

**K-2 Mixed Media Makers | June 19-23 | Monday-Friday | 9am-3pm | \$455**

Explore sculpture, foil art, mosaics and more in this multi-media camp. Students will use various materials to create designs to bring their ideas to life. There will be a different material provided each day to generate creative and detailed works of art.

**3-5 Fantasy Home Design | June 19-30 (two-week camp) | Monday-Friday | 9am-3pm | \$910**

In this two week immersive camp, students will learn about interior design to plan and make their dream home using real dollhouse kits. Campers will then explore printmaking techniques to create wallpaper, mold clay to make miniature household objects, and use other materials to construct their own doll-sized furniture. Students will leave this camp with a fully-usable mini-home that they can play with over and over again.

**K-2 Space Adventures | June 26-30 | Monday-Friday | 9am-3pm | \$455**

Join us for a week-long exploration of space! Students will use different mediums to create galaxy paintings, spaceships, alien monsters, and star drawings. Add a pop of moon dust or a glitter of comet trails to make your work "outta this world!"

**1-3 Junkestra | July 5-7 | Wednesday, Thursday, Friday (No Camp 7/3 or 7/4) | 9am-3pm | \$294**

**K-2 Toys and Games | July 10-14 | Monday-Friday | 9am-3pm | \$455**

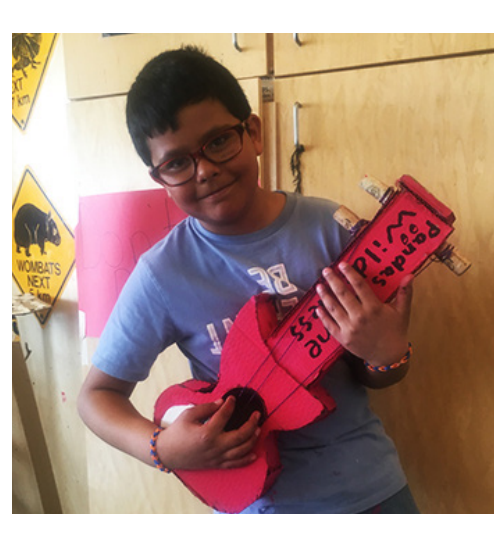
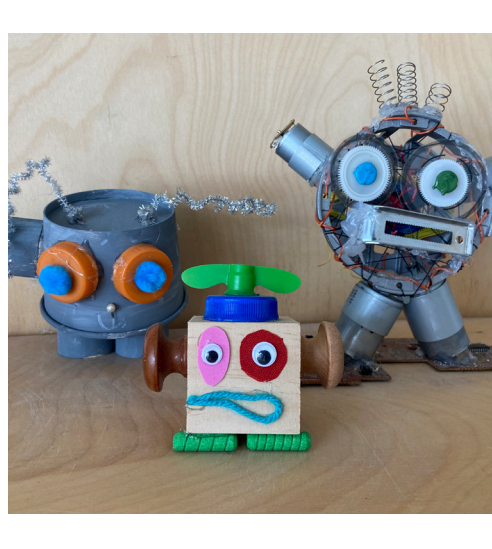
In this camp, students will design, create and build various toys and games! Using materials both recycled and new, students will build toy cars, catapults, memory games and more!

In this camp, make your own set, story and film over the course of a week. Together we will learn specific techniques to create amazing films in drawing and in clay.
