

Multi-Purpose Studio Etiquette

We suggest wearing comfortable, washable clothes and closed toed shoes. Aprons are available. Studio users under 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Clean Up

*Allow 20-30 minutes for clean-up at the end of your work session. Please be thorough.

- <u>Tables and Floor</u>- wipe down the entire work area with a rag after use and sweep/mop debris.
- <u>Tools</u>- studio equipment must be cleaned and returned to its proper place after every use.
- <u>Air Filter</u>- the JET fan is located above the wedging tables. Please feel free to turn it on while cleaning or if you feel that there is dust in the air.
- <u>Sawdust</u>- the shop vac is available for your use. Please vacuum sawdust instead of sweeping for your safety.

Equipment

*If any piece of equipment breaks or if you notice something odd, please tell the Studio Coordinator or any member of the Art Association staff.

The following equipment requires training and/or authorization before use:

- Soldering Station
- Glass Kiln
- Enameling Kiln
- Welding Equipment
- Woodworking Machines

Precious Metal Recycling

- <u>Large recycling bucket</u>- the white recycling PMR bucket is for any and all scraps swept from the floor or the desks.
- <u>Small recycling container</u> the small recycling PMR container (located to the right of the polishing machines) is for small scraps of metal and silver.

Safety & Security

- There are multiple types of gloves and masks located around the studio. Please make sure to wear safety equipment when necessary.
- Fire extinguishers and sand buckets are located by the soldering station.
- A first aid kit is located to the left of the sink.
- An eye wash station is located above the soldering stations.
- Evening students may remain in the studio after class is over.
- The last student, member or instructor to leave the studio must turn off all lights and make sure all doors are closed.
